

Please excuse any typos etc...."






The winery offered great open spaces for the dogs to run and not so bad wine!

Part of traveling is getting to visit friends and relatives. We wanted to incorporate that into this trip rather than go petal to the metal.


So, we visited the Fort Worth Stockyards where the drive long horns through the street, have great TX bbq, and tons of things to see.

Directions: (Be sure to check resort's website, pull out your maps and charge your GPS!) From Los Angeles, and from experience, the easiest way is to: Take I-10E to Hwy 86S just past Indio and head south toward the Salton Sea. Exit onto S22 at Salton City and head west. Note: first 4 miles of S22 is full of whoop-dee-doos. Take your time.

If you take I-15 south to Hwy 79S to S2 you can continue to 78E to S3 and approach Borrego from the south, or take S22 at Ranchita and drive slowly and with care down the 8% Montezuma Grade.

For the most part there is no cell service/internet, so it's a great place to truly escape for the weekend! Check in time is 3:00 pm, check out 11:00am. Please contact to park directly for any variance.

Meals Included in Fee Sat. and Sun breakfasts. What to Bring: A dish to share for Sat pot luck, your own drinks for Friday/Saturday Happy hour, your own coffee, plates, silverware

**Directions:** Driving north or south on Highway 101 take the Grand Ave Exit in Arroyo Grande. Turn east onto Grand Ave and head towards the mountains. You will drive through old town Arroyo Grande to Huasna Road. Turn right onto Huasna Road. Huasna Road becomes Lopez Drive. Stay on Lopez Drive for approximately 10 miles. At this point the road ends at the entrance to Lopez Lake. (Signs are posted along the way.) Park is on your left hand side.

Additional fees to be paid individually upon arrival: \$3.50 per pet per day. Motorized boats \$10, non-motorized boats \$5, sailboards \$3. If you intend on bringing any type of boat, follow the inspection procedures found on: www.slocountyparks.com/information/quagga\_info\_asof\_4\_6\_10.pdf
