

Paula Poll is the gueen of the road trips and has always taken her time to give us honest and frank critique when touring the American Southwest. We have never felt judged for being a comparatively younger British family with an old clapped out trailer and unreliable tow vehicle, who always turn up late to a rally on a Friday and that are always interrupting conversation as chasing after Edward around the campsite. Edward instantly has found lots of Airstream grandparents when we joined CCC. You have watched him grow and watched him explore and absolutely spoil him rotten! Edward never seems to leave a rally without lots of attention nor empty handed as someone always gets him a little present or treat. This is very kind.
